

Healing of Cancer in Jaw and Neck (25/8/10)

My name is Oliver and in December 2009, I went to a dentist for the first time as I had never been to before. While checking my teeth, the dentist accidentally discovered a lump in my left jaw. She sent me to a dental surgeon to have the lump removed. The lump was sent to the Prince of Wales Hospital Cancer Unit to determine if it was cancerous. The test proved positive. I then had to go to the hospital for further tests. The tests showed that I had cancer on the left jaw and neck. That was in February 2010. So I asked the church for prayer, initially by a prayer request, and later I went forward to the invitation for prayer at the front of the church at the end of a 9:30am Sunday morning service at Petersham Assembly of God. A member of the prayer team prayed for me. He spoke to the cancer and commanded it to leave my neck, jaw and any other parts of my body in Jesus' name.

At the hospital the doctor gave me two options: either immediate intensive radiation treatment for six weeks followed by an operation if necessary or an operation followed by radiation if need be. I chose the first option. At the end of February, I started the intensive radiation treatment for six weeks. After the six-week treatment, I had to go back for monthly reviews for the doctor to check the progress of the radiation. The church continued to pray for me.

In April, May and June, I went for the reviews. According to the doctor, if everything went according to plan, the cancer would have disappeared by May or June, but July came and he still wasn't sure that the cancer had gone. He sent me to the Royal Prince Alfred Hospital for a PET-CT scan. The results were that they could find no trace of cancer in my jaw and neck!

While, at the moment, I continue to have my monthly check-ups, I truly believe that God has healed me. I also believe and thank God that He sovereignly moved in such a way that he caused me to go to a dentist who discovered the lump in my jaw after all these years, I had not been aware that I had cancer. Praise God!
